

Aussie Events and Amusements Inflatable Safety Rules

Unsupervised items are not covered by insurance whilst on hire

The hiree will provide a person eighteen (18) years or over capable of exercising authority over children and shall supervise the use of the equipment at all times and in particular, shall ensure:

- ★ That they have a continuous clear and unobstructed view of the equipment and the children thereon;
- ★ That only so many children are allowed onto the equipment at any one time as can safely use the same without causing danger to themselves and others – MAXIMUM 8-10 CHILDREN;
- ★ That larger or more boisterous children are segregated from smaller children;
- ★ That children do not climb or hang on walls and must be seated when going down the slide;
- ★ That no person/s using the equipment has any hard, sharp or dangerous objects on their person, such as buckles, pens, purses, or spectacles, and that ALL PERSON/S REMOVE THEIR SHOES;
- ★ That no children more than the age of ten (10) years of age uses equipment sized 4m x 4m or smaller, twelve years of age uses the larger equipment with the exception of "THE FORTRESS", "BUMPER BOUNCER" and GIANT INFLATABLE SLIDE (suitable for persons up to 95 kilos);
- ★ NO FOOD, DRINK or PETS are to be taken onto the inflatable;
- ★ NO SAND should be allowed to enter the inflatable;
- ★ NO STREAMERS or CREPE PAPER should be allowed to come into contact with the inflatable due to the staining properties of the paper;
- ★ No FACE PAINT is allowed unless it is water based and perfectly dried. No oil based paints are allowed;
- ★ Anchorage points remain secure and all ropes or other means of securing the inflatable are not touched or disturbed in anyway;
- ★ That the equipment is **NOT** TURNED OFF OR INTERFERED WITH, especially during periods of wet weather, but with the exception of gale force winds.
